## Finances

- Treasurer's report

Brought in approximately $\$ 6,000$ in dues and spend approximately $\$ 4,500$
League currently has approximately $\$ 31,000$ in funds, of which approximately $\$ 3,000$ is 420/coordinator funds owed back to schools.

- Disposition of 420 and Coordinator funds

6 School are still owed money back. This will be sent back by this Spring.

- Budget and Dues

Budgets and dues same as last year. MBL end of year regatta will have no fee again this year.
Dues to be at $\$ 200$ per team; same as last year. All schools voted in favor of accepting these dues.

## Update on NESSA

Mark Trophy to have 8 schools again this year; Terk to have 8 schools as well. Both regattas will be run in same format.
NESSA will run a Women's Event again this year with qualifier regattas.
Techscore will be used at all NESSA events. Teams should make sure to register with ISSA correctly.

## Procedural rules issues

Proposal from the president
Motion to amend the Procedural Rules section 9 Divisional Rules, provision a, "A Division", paragraph v for the 2016 season by adding the italicized text to the current rule.

Each team must race at least three (3) team races against NESSA teams that are not members of MBL. If any team does not satisfy this requirement, each meet not sailed shall count as a loss for the purpose of divisional standings. Teams that fail to meet this requirement for two consecutive years shall be excluded from the A division the subsequent year. After some discussion, this motion was tabled to be revisited later in the night after the divisional realignment discussion was complete. Motion was not voted on later in the night.

## An A Division with 2 subdivisions and a B Division with 2 subdivisions.

$A$ subdivisions and $B$ subdivisions are approximately equal in size, but $B$ subdivisions are larger than $A$ subdivisions. Both $A$ and $B$ have a playoff system to determine Year End Awards.
Each Division also has a separate team race tournament.
