#### **Finances**

• Treasurer's report

Brought in approximately \$6,000 in dues and spend approximately \$4,500 League currently has approximately \$31,000 in funds, of which approximately \$3,000 is 420/coordinator funds owed back to schools.

Techscore will be used at all NESSA events. Teams should make sure to register with ISSA correctly.

### **Procedural rules issues**

Proposal from the president

Motion to amend the Procedural Rules section 9 Divisional Rules, provision a, "A Division", paragraph v for the 2016 season by adding the italicized text to the current rule.

Each team must race at least three (3) team races against NESSA teams that are not members of MBL. If any team does not satisfy this requirement, each meet not sailed shall count as a loss for the purpose of divisional standings. *Teams that fail to meet this requirement for two consecutive years shall be excluded from the A division the subsequent year.* After some discussion, this motion was tabled to be revisited later in the night after the divisional realignment discussion was complete. Motion was not voted on later in the night.
