Proposal to require scheduling best of 5 meets

Proposal was accepted to change section 3(b) of the Procedural Rules as shown:

b. Competition between MBL teams is defined as a meet consisting of a series of races held in a single day. For a team racing meet, a minimum shall be the best of three races. Team racing meets shall be scheduled as best of five races, but may be shortened to a minimum of best of three races when conditions warrant and with agreement of both coaches. For fleet racing meets, there shall be a minimum of three races

Championship Regatta at CBI

Allocation of CBI boats on Day 1: 7 boats from A, 6 boats from B, 5 boats from C, based on season standings. If necessary, ties will be broken by head to head competition first, then NESSA standings.

Day 2 allocation – top 18 teams on day 1 will get CBI boats on Day 2.
